The themes and descriptors in this table show our school's joint definition of high-quality teaching for ALL students. This was collectively defined through a provision review involving open discussions with staff, parents & carers, pupils and governors in November 2020.

Themes	Descriptors
We help each child to develop academically, whatever their starting points.	 Teachers are able to identify pupils' starting points through a range of assessment tools. Staff know each pupil well and adapt how they teach to suit. Children are supported to make progress through targeted work and appropriate interventions. Our pupils' work in core subjects is marked with targets for improvement and children are given time in lessons to edit it. We celebrate what the children do well but always challenge them to go a little further.
We offer a safe and supportive learning environment for all of our pupils.	 Our top priority is to ensure our children are, and feel, safe. We cater for our children's physical and emotional needs, and understand the need to focus on pupils' well-being. Our pupils know who to approach if they have any worries. Everyone is responsible for making our school community feel valued and welcome. The learning environment in our classrooms is supportive and conducive to extending learning.
We develop the whole pupil, not just the academic.	 We understand that all of our children are unique and use a One Page Profile to get to know our pupils. We facilitate a number of extended curriculum activities by commissioning specialists. We organise a range of exciting educational visits and residentials; outdoor activity is encouraged. Our pupils are able to be part of a number of pupil groups including school council, prefects and buddies. Our links with local secondary schools enable participation in new experiences and events, such as sporting competitions and drama productions.
We have effective relationships with parents and are part of the wider community.	 Our staff, pupils and .parents are part of our Priorslee team. We have an excellent communication network and share positive messages with the wider school community. Family concerns can be shared and resolved using a range of communication methods. We listen to our parents and are always open to suggestions to improve our practice. Our relationships reflect a family approach and serve to enhance a wider community ethos.
We engage our pupils' learning and encourage their development.	 We have teachers who engage our pupils with interactive, informative and interesting lessons. We stimulate children's learning with established routines, purposeful seating, visual structures and supportive displays. We help to develop children's personalities by using a range of teaching strategies. Our whole class reading system reflects our children's interests and needs. Technology is used to compliment children's learning.
